#### **Synopsis:**

A bride's personal nightmare unfolds, when her husband is arrested at the altar for the murder of a stripper at his bachelor party. We follow her journey to prove the innocence of the man she adores, despite spiralling suspicion against him.

**Episode: 1/13 Duration: 24' Rating: 16**

#### **Synopsis:**

Two families gather at a wedding resort outside Jo'burg for the wedding of Sanele and Lindiwe. But as they exchange vows, the police arrive and arrest the groom on murder charges. The body of the stripper who danced at the bachelor's party has been discovered, her hands bound with the tie Sanele was wearing. With her dreams shattered, Lindiwe realises that it's up to her prove Sanele's innocence. But if he didn't kill her, then who did?

**Episode: 2/13 Duration: 24' Rating: 16**

#### **Synopsis:**

Sanele's arrest becomes real as he makes his first appearance in court. Lindiwe's journey to uncover the truth about Anzani begins.

**Episode: 3/13 Duration: 24' Rating: 16**

#### **Synopsis:**

Lindiwe visits Sanele in jail and more suspects emerge. Later, Lindiwe takes new evidence to the police.

**Episode: 4/13 Duration: 24' Rating: 16**

**Synopsis:**

Lindiwe grows suspicious of the relationship between Tumi and the Judge. Still reeling from the news of his infidelity she fails to visit Sanele, who slides deeper into the ignominy of prison life. Meanwhile Lindiwe and Vuyo grow closer.

**Episode: 5/13 Duration: 24' Rating: 16**

**Synopsis:**

Lindiwe is crushed by Sanele's betrayal and can't ignore the evidence anymore: her husband killed a woman. Angry and hurt, Lindiwe starts to consider the end of her marriage that has hardly just started. Meanwhile in jail, Sanele starts to feel the walls closing in and the allies swindling. Desperate, Sanele looks to join Xobo's gang in a daring prison break. As Lindiwe watches those around her seemingly benefitting off Sanele's misfortune, she is drawn back to her husband's corner.

**Episode: 6/13 Duration: 24' Rating: 16**

**Synopsis:**

The evidence against Sanele is mounting and he desperately wants to prove his own innocence. Xobo and Sanele put in motion their plan to escape from jail. Lindiwe's investigation leads her back to Kloofzicht Lodge, even though she's terrified of her uncle she agrees to let him accompany her.

**Episode: 7/13 Duration: 24' Rating: 16**

**Synopsis:**

Lindiwe is revved up again and back in Sanele's corner. Her theory that Bongani has framed Sanele to get his hands on the business, is brought to a halt when Anzani's phone reveals a scandalous Mweli family secret; one that could also exonerate Sanele. But Dineo is wary to expose family scandals and seeks Sanele's advice on the matter. Meanwhile, Sanele's gang hits

a snag and have to pay off a guard. But then Sanele discovers that Xobo and the others have taken him for a ride, getting money out of him. Sanele decides to go at it alone and manages to break out of jail; just as Lungile finds evidence that will exonerate him. But Lungile's evidence never makes it to ears that matter, because he is killed before he can share what he has discovered.

**Episode: 8/13 Duration: 24' Rating: 16**

**Synopsis:**

Sanele makes contact, revealing his escape. Lindiwe is even more suspicious of him when it is discovered that Lungile has been killed. Unathi figures out that Lindiwe has the most motive for the murder and subsequent framing of her brother. Grace does not like all the secrets being kept by her family members.

**Episode: 9/13 Duration: 24' Rating: 16**

**Synopsis:**

Sanele is on the run and still desperate to prove his innocence. Lindiwe tells him the "Family Secret" and he goes to confront his father. Grace goes on her mission to try uncover what Judge Jacob has been keeping from her. Lerato is put under tremendous pressure at work to deliver on the Mveli story.

**Episode: 10/13 Duration: 24' Rating: 16**

**Synopsis:**

Sanele and Lindiwe's relationship is on the rocks, as mistrust surfaces. They both decided for their relationship sake Sanele must hand himself in and let the law take its course. They promise to stand together no matter what, but things take a turn when the murder weapon is found in hidden Sanele's car.

**Episode: 11/13 Duration: 24' Rating: 16**

**Synopsis:**

Lindiwe knows she's getting closer to the killer as someone is watching her every move. Feeling she is unsafe, Vuyo opens his house to Lindiwe. Back at the newspaper, Lerato finds out

about Jacob and Mlungisi and decides to run with that story. But Jacob will do everything in his power to stop it going to print. With Vuyo as her dependable confidante, Lindiwe starts to think things are looking up, until she is forced to once again doubt Sanele - this time for good. In jail, Sanele learns that crossing a jailbird has hard consequences. Add to his problems, his wife is once again not on his side and it's back to square one. Vuyo finds himself Dineo's only trusted ally.

**Episode: 12/13 Duration: 24' Rating: 16**

**Synopsis:**

Lindiwe regrets sleeping with Vuyo and wants to go home, but Vuyo convinces her to stay. She recovers the SME print out from Lungile's things and begins to put the final pieces of the puzzle together. Judge Mveli almost goes public about his affair with Mlungisi, but Grace stops him. Vuyo blackmails the Judge into adding his name to a list of judgeships. Dineo discovers who the murderer really is and is in grave danger.

**Episode: 13/13 Duration: 24' Rating: 16**

**Synopsis:**

Vuyo chases Lindiwe through the house and catches her and drags her down to the basement where he chains her to the wall. He leaves and in desperation, Lindiwe records a series of messages on Anzani's phone to tell the truth of the murders. Meanwhile Vuyo gets presented as a candidate for a judgeship and Mlungisi visits Sanele in prison but gets tied up and tortured. Lerato senses Lindiwe is in danger and brings Captain Dube to Lindiwe's house and they find nothing until.
